'Copies of any and all documents (including but not limited to physical or electronic or written briefs, internal discussion papers, minutes, emails and other correspondence) regarding the 'Reach for the Facts' campaign on opioid use, total public expenditure on the campaign, and measures of effectiveness for the period 1/01/2019 to 6/05/2021'.

By email of 10 May 2021, Patrick Stewart of your Office revised the scope of the application to the following documents:

*'The approval process for the campaign;
Expenditure by RTWSA on the campaign; and
Measures of effectiveness of the campaign.*

We'd also be seeking copies of any Ministerial briefings prepared on this issue'.
